1. Certifier Type	Name, title, address (including country), phone & email
2. Blanket Period	Include the period if the certificate covers multiple shipments
3. Producer	Name, address (including country), phone & email. Only provide if different from certifier or exporter If multiple producers state "Various" or provide a list May maintain confidentiality with "Available upon request by the importing authorities" Address shall be the place of production of the good in a Party's territory
4. Importer	Name, address (including country), phone & email Address shall be in a Party's territory
5. Exporter	Name, address (including country), phone & email Only provide if different than the Certifier Not required if completed by the producer & the exporter is unknown Address shall be the place of export of the good in a Party's territory
