Certificate of Origin Instructions

Instructions on completing your USMCA Certificate of Origin. Note that no specific form is required as long as all required data elements are included. Do not use the NAFTA certificate because after July 1 it will not be valid.

1. Certifier Type	Name, title, address (including country), phone & email			
2. Blanket Period	Include the period if the certificate covers multiple shipments			
3. Producer	Name, address (including country), ph <mark>one</mark> & email.			
	Only provide if different from certifier or exporter			
	If multiple producers state "Various" or provide a list			
	May maintain confidentiality with "Available upon request by the importing authorities"			
	Address shall be the place of production of the good in a Party's territory			
4. Importer	Name, address (including country), phone & email			
	Address shall be in a Party's territory			
5. Exporter	Name, address (including country), phone & email			
	Only provide if different than the Certifier			
	Not required if completed by the producer & the exporter is unknown			
	Address shall be the place of export of the good in a Party's territory			
6. Part Number	Only provide part numbers if you don't anticipate the part numbers to change for the period of the blanket certificate			
7. Description of Good(s)	Provide a full description of each good. The description should be sufficient to relate it to the invoice description and to the Harmonized System (HS) description of the good.			
8. HS Tariff Classification	6-digit level (XXXX.XX)			
	Description should be sufficient to relate it to the good covered by certification			
9. Origin Criteria	Specify the origin criteria set out in Article 4.2			
10. Country of Origin	Identify the country of origin of the good (CA, US, or MX)

Date	Must be signed and dated by the certifier & must be accompanied by the following statement: "I certify that the goods described in this document gualify as originating and the information contained in this			
	document are true and accurate. I assume responsibility for proving such representations and agree to maintain and			
	present upon request or to make available during a verification visit, documentation necessary to support this certification."
